

**CALL FOR ENTRIES**  
**"MAIN STREET---GRAND JUNCTION 2013"**

Exhibit Dates: July-August-September, 2013

Deadline: June 15, 2013 NO EXCEPTIONS

**THEME:** Visual inspiration from Main Street, from 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> Street.

It can be Abstract or visual interpretation. *It must be original work for this show.*

**TWO CHALLENGES:**

**"MAIN STREET -GRAND JUNCTION 2013"—Art quilt—Smallest size 24"x24"**

**Largest size 36" x72"**

**"3-D ART"—three dimensional quilt art up to 14" long, it can weigh up to five pounds.**

(YOU MUST get written permission from the original artist when using the original art work from Main Street.

**DESIGN RULES:**

- All pieces must be the ORIGINAL work of AQuA members. No quilt may be constructed using a commercial pattern. No commercial machine quilting patterns may be used.
- If the quilt was begun in a workshop, the workshop teacher's name and technique must be credited on the back. A workshop teacher's pattern is not acceptable, only the technique.
- No more than two (2) AQuA members may collaborate on the construction of a quilt and both members must be listed on the entry form.
- Diptychs and triptychs are acceptable providing their size, including space between the pieces, remains within the size restrictions.
- Quilts submitted for entry may not be altered in any way (sleeve included) until the conclusion of the show.

**SLEEVE REQUIREMENTS:** A top sleeve is required on the back of the quilt. Please consult the instructions on our Website under "Member Information." This technique is mandatory.

**SLAT:** 1" to 2" size slat will be need to work with the 'J' hanging system. Holes need to drilled 1/2 " from each end.

**LABEL:** A cloth label must be sewn to the back side of the quilt. The label must include the title of the quilt and your name. You may include additional contact information, but it is not required.

**ARTIST STATEMENT AND BIO:** To be included in a book located at City Hall. Please make a statement about yourself, and your life as an artist. Also make a biography statement about yourself. Please limit to one page, front side containing both the artist statement and the Bio.

**ENTRY FEE:** There will be a non-refundable fee of \$5.00 for each entry, up to two quilt entries, and one 3-D entry.

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** Quality photography is required for all quilts. The profession photography fee is \$20.00 for each quilt or 3-D piece, which will include a full shot and one close up. You will receive a CD with your quilt images. You may also arrange for your own professional photographer. If using another photographer, then a two-color digital image (full & close-up) must be submitted on a CD-ROM. Digital images must be 300 dpi minimum, at least 4 x 6 and saved in jpeg format. The CD must be turned in on 6/15/13 with your quilt. The photography fee is refundable if your quilt is disqualified from the show due to sleeve or size requirements, although you may still have your quilt photographed if you wish.

**DUE DATE:** June 15, 2013 and absolutely no exceptions will be made.

**JURYING:** There will be no jury process for the 2013 City Hall show.

**MEMBERS CHOICE:** All members present at June 15, 2013 AQuA meeting will vote for their one favorite as "Member's Choice." The Member's Choice will be featured on our website. We will choose one quilt and one 3-D piece.

**PET HAIR:** Please be sure that your quilt is free of pet hair when you turn it in.

**THE KEEPER'S OF QUILT GUIDELINE REGULATIONS FOR SHOWS** will examine each quilt after submission. All quilts must meet the above guidelines.
