

## Deborah Fell Workshop Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order capable of a straight & zigzag stitch (and feet and plates)
- Basic sewing supplies
  - Including both paper and cloth scissors
- Fat quarters, 5-6, in the same color family as your paint
  - Fabrics should relate
  - Include light, medium and dark values + one zinger
  - Subtle patterns work best
- 1 yard each of both light & dark with subtle pattern—to use as a base fabric
- 2 yards fusible webbing such as Wonder Under
- 2 yards neutral color duck cloth (most fabric stores carry)
- 3 colors, (at least 2 oz. ) of fluid acrylic paint—red family, blue family, yellow family.

  - Transparent works well
- One bottle Scribbles 3-D black paint (any craft store)
- Acrylic gel medium, Matte, small size
  - Can be bought in GJ at Michaels or online at places like [Dick Blick](#)
- Basic paint supplies such as brushes (bring a variety), containers, apron, and texture tools
- Unconventional painting tools such as toothpicks, old toothbrushes, anything you can create textures with
- Mixed media paper pad or other kind of paper you have in studio (Bristol, watercolor)
  - Mixed media paper is ‘sturdy’ and holds up to wet media
- Pad of canvas paper (more is you work fast)
  - 8x10“ is a good working size
  - This is available locally at Michaels under the “Artist Loft” brand and can be found elsewhere
- Small container for water at your table
- Thin black sharpie pen
- Optional latex gloves
- Stencils or stamps if you have them
- Ziploc bag of Fabric scraps
  - Try to coordinate the fabric with your paint choices
  - Bring those little bits of edges and small leftovers you always knew could be used somewhere
- Small box of ephemera:
  - Lightweight tissue weight papers (wrapping, sewing papers, etc)
  - Old newspapers, magazines images.... Recycled or repurposed materials
  - Found objects such as rusty bottle tops, textured paper
  - Mixed media miscellanea you have at home
- Note taking materials
- Class size design wall
- 1-2 irons and ironing boards, and Teflon sheets for use by the entire class
