NOVEMBER 11, 2023

Sharon opened the meeting with a discussion of our survey establishing where and when to meet. This second survey ended in a tie, which was the case of the first survey. Mary gave a report on the Mancuso show in Pennsylvania. She was quite impressed with the thoughtful way the show was hung. When we have a venue with a projector available, she will show photos of our exhibit.

Mary had also gone to Provo, Utah, to see the SAQA Primal Forces: Earth exhibition on the BYU campus. There were two definitions of Art Quilt provided. One was SAQA's and the other was our AQUA definition.

Our first Mancuso show in 2024 is the PAC International. Our theme for that show is "Wild and Whacky". Those pieces are due at our May 18 meeting.
