Meeting started at 1:00 pm.

Becky reviewed the current Treasurer's Report. There is currently \$15,079.02 in the bank.

There was a discussion of the Retreat and Jacque confirmed that it was much better to have a specific per person budget amount for the 3 days. Jacque said that she will be in charge of the Retreat again next year and she has reserved The Chipeta Golf Course club house for March 5, 6 and 7 of 2026. The cost will remain the same as this year at \$100 per day. The member cost for the Retreat will be determined when it is closer.

The AQuA finances were audited and reviewed by Becky, Judy Allerheiligen and Tana LaDuke. The only question that came up was how cash payments from members was handled. The Steers discussed options for keeping better track of cash payments and decided on the following:

On meeting days when a payment of some kind is due there will be two lines - one for those paying with a check and one for those paying with cash. People paying with cash will need to provide a post-it note with the cash indicating the amount and what the cash is for as well as signing a form that indicates that they paid in cash. This form will be kept on file. Also, those paying by check need to indicate on the check what they are paying for. If they are paying for more than one item at the same time, for example: Dues and a workshop payment, they should indicate what each individual payment is and the total.
